

# Kids Pottery Classes

## A creative and confidence-boosting experience for young makers!

Let your child explore the magic of clay with our expert led pottery classes in a fun, relaxed studio environment. All kids classes are private bookings. You'll have exclusive use of the studio during your session, so it's just your group and our experienced teachers.

All classes include tuition, materials, glazing, and firing. Finished pieces are food and liquid safe—perfect for proud displays or everyday use!

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### 1) Pottery Wheel Class (Ages 9+)

**£60 per student | 1.5 hours | Max 6 students | Minimum 4 students**

A hands-on introduction to throwing on the wheel, tailored for kids aged 9 and up. With one student per wheel, everyone gets quality time practicing and learning basic throwing techniques.

- Includes 3 finished pieces per student
- All materials, glazing, and firings included

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### 2) Wheel & Handbuilding Combo Class (Ages 9+)

**£65 per student | 2 hours | For groups of 10–12 students**

This dynamic session includes both wheel throwing and handbuilding! Students are split into two groups, rotating halfway through so everyone gets to try both techniques.

- Two teachers guiding small groups
- Includes 3 finished pieces per student
- All materials, glazing, and firings included

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### 3) Handbuilding Class (Ages 5+)

**£50 per student | 1.5 hours | 5–12 students | Minimum 5 students**

Great for younger kids or those who prefer working off the wheel, this class teaches foundational handbuilding skills. Each student will make up to 3 pieces using pinch, coil, and slab techniques.

- Includes 3 finished pieces per student
- All materials, glazing, and firings included

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## After the Class

Each student will:

- Choose 2 glaze colours from our in-studio selection
- Have their pieces trimmed, glazed, and fired by our team
- Be able to collect their finished pottery in **4–5 weeks**

We use high-quality stoneware clay and food-safe glazes. All pieces are fired twice in our studio kiln—first at 1000°C, then at 1250°C after glazing.

We dedicate time after each session to finish every piece with care, ensuring the work your child creates is both beautiful and lasting.

We also inscribe each piece with the student's initials and the date of the class (on the base) creating a lasting keepsake they can treasure for years to come.

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## Why Our Pricing Reflects More Than Just Class Time

Each class is carefully planned and prepared to give kids the best possible experience with clay. Here's what your booking includes:

- **Pre-class preparation:** Clay is weighed and wedged, tools are set out, wheels are cleaned and ready, and demonstration pieces are made to guide students.
- **Skilled instruction:** Sessions are taught by experienced, passionate potters who thoroughly enjoy passing on their skills creating a supportive environment.
- **All materials:** Stoneware clay, use of studio equipment, tools and a curated glaze selection.
- **Post-class finishing:** Each piece is trimmed, glazed, and fired twice in my electric kiln—a process that takes up to 4-5 weeks.
- **Studio cleanup:** We encourage kids to explore, get messy, and have fun, which also means a thorough cleanup of the studio after every session.
- **Reclaim:** Any unused clay or work that isn't kept will be re-used again for another session. We have a reclaim system in the studio where nothing gets wasted. We soak all used clay and then dry it out on plaster boards to rework again.
